Travel Consultant Responsibilities

Although Internet travel websites have made it easier for individuals to plan their own vacations or trips, travel **consultants**—also known as travel agents—still provide valuable services, particularly for clients traveling internationally. Agents must have a **thorough** understanding of business, geography, **marketing** and the travel industry. Clients depend on their travel consultants to make their trip or vacation go as **smoothly** as possible.

Evaluating Destinations

Clients expect their travel consultant to have thorough knowledge of a

destination. While studying travel **literature** and guides is important, some travel agents take on the responsibility of **personally** visiting destinations to **evaluate** their **suitability** for tourists. They examine the attractions and entertainment **available** in the city or country. Consultants also visit restaurants, **resorts** and hotels to determine their quality. They may consult with other travel agents or clients to find out detailed information about destinations and hotels or attractions they **recommend**. Travel Guidance and Assistance

The **primary** responsibility of a travel consultant is to provide guidance and **assistance** for clients. This goes beyond just the essential tasks of securing discounts and arranging travel, hotel accommodations or tour **participation**. Consultants educate their clients about all aspects of their travel destination. This includes information about the location's culture, laws, climate and travel **regulations**. Consultants must know about **immunization** requirements as well. They also must prepare travelers for their destination's **monetary** exchange rates. Agents advise clients about the most convenient or **efficient** ways of dealing with their travel finances. For example, the American Society of Travel Agents (ASTA) suggests that consultants make travel **arrangements** for locations that have a similar monetary value to the clients' home country. They also recommend that agents advise clients to choose vacation packages that allow them to pay in their home country's money **prior** to the trip.

Some travel consultants develop travel packages for their employer. This can allow clients to pay one **lump** sum for **transportation**, accommodations, entertainment, tours and meals at a particular destination. Agents investigate a destination and arrange for complete packages.

Asian Dragon Bay (Yalong Bay)

A sandy beach, blue sky, and beautiful scenery of the sea present a prime land — the Asian Dragon Bay (Yalong Bay) with a charming scene. The bay stretches from east to west, covers 50 square kilometers of sea area and there are five islands. The coastline along the bay is 20 kilometers long and the seaport is about 8 kilometers wide. It is one of the famous scenic spots in Hainan Province. Asian Dragon Bay also has comfortably climate, only 22° C (68° F). This incredible comfort climate would last 300 days per year.

Asian Dragon Bay boasts the five essential elements of modern tourism; sea, sands, sunshine, green plants and fresh air. The scenery is amazing, with endless rolling hills, quiet gulfs, clear blue sea and silvery sand beaches. It is honored as "Oriental Hawaii" with fantastic scenery. Home to several well-preserved coral reefs with tropical fish of varied kinds, colors and shapes, the ocean here is crystal clear, allowing visitors to view underwater sights up to 10 meters (33 feet) deep from the surface. The unique state-level tourist resort is characterized by its tropical environment — the resort holds seaside parks, deluxe villas, conference centers, top-end hotels, golf-courses and so on. In recent years, with the perfection of facilities, thousands of travelers are attracted by its unique charm to swarm to this ideal place for vacation.

In the centre of Asian Dragon Bay square stands a Totem Pole of 27 meters (about 88.6 feet), on which the God of Sun, and Gods of Wind, Rain, and Thunder as well as those legendary animals such as Dragon, Phoenix, Kylin and Fish are engraved. The design of this square embodies the Chinese civilization of 5,000 years and has received recognition in winning the Luban Prize, which is awarded to the top level design of architecture in China.

With an area of 3,000 square meters (about 3,558 square yards), Shell Hall of Asian Dragon Bay is located in the central square of the resort. And with the shell as its theme, the Shell Hall is a comprehensive exhibition hall combining exhibition and shopping. When traveling through the hall, visitors will be surrounded by natural wonders.

In the north of Asian Dragon Bay is the site of Butterfly Valley, which is classified into five halls that present the most precious species of butterflies in China and other countries as well.

Sun always shines; general sea wave, beautiful seashore, and mountains with no pollution make Asian Dragon Bay quite different from other bays in Asia. Today, Asian Dragon Bay is a well-known tourist resort and becomes quite popular.
